The skills and concepts listed will be explored, but mastery of all concepts is not expected.

Toddlers (18-24 months)

Social Development

- Learn playing etiquette
- Experience working with others
- Be taught how to share
- Learn manners

Language Development

- Begin to communicate needs
- Learn listening skills
- Be able to follow instructions
- Introduce simple sign language
- Recognize their written name

Fine Motor Skills

- Learn to hold crayons, markers and paintbrushes
- Use fingers and hands to manipulate objects
- Play with and complete simple puzzles
- Practice stacking, sorting and other activities to encourage eye-hand coordination

Science/Health

- Identify parts of the body
- Learn about weather and seasons
- Be introduced to animals, vegetation and marine life
- Explore the five senses and their uses

Mathematics

- Be introduced to basic shapes
- Practice counting from 1-5
- Sort objects by color

Creative Arts

- Participate in movement songs and dances
- Begin to identify colors
- Dramatic play
- Use of a variety of art materials

Spiritual Development

- Hear Bible stories
- Learn about God's love through story and song
