Two's

Social Development

- Play alone, in small groups and large groups
- Take care of basic needs: wash hands, use tissue, put away belongings, etc.
- Be taught how to share and work together
- Practice using manners

Language Development

- Clearly communicate needs
- Learn listening skills
- Be able to follow multi-step instructions
- Learn simple sign language
- Recognize their written name
- Exposure to the alphabet and phonetic sounds
- Build new vocabulary

Fine Motor Skills

- Efficiently hold crayons, markers and paintbrushes
- Learn to trace straight lines
- Begin using safety scissors
- Learn to button, zip and snap clothing
- Use fingers and hands to manipulate objects
- Play with and complete puzzles
- Practice lacing and stringing beads and other activities that develop eye-hand coordination

Science/Health

- Identify parts of the body
- Learn about weather, seasons and the calendar
- Be introduced to animals, vegetation and marine life
- Explore the five senses and their uses
- Experience the world through nature walks

Mathematics

- Learn basic shapes
- Be able to count from 1-10
- Sort objects by color, shape and size
- Same and different

Creative Arts

- Participate in movement songs and dances
- Identify colors
- Dramatic play
- Use of a variety of art materials

Spiritual Development
